



CSPWC/SFA Juried Exhibition: FAQs

Who is accepted into this exhibition?

This juried exhibition is open to elected members in *good standing* of the CSPWC only.

Deadlines

- Entries must be received by **March 30, 2018** for the jurying process
- Results for the selected/unselected work will be given during the middle of April.
- Instructions for delivery of works will be sent out immediately afterwards.

What size of Painting will be accepted? What is the Paper size?

Size:

Size of work: Only two sizes are accepted. These sizes comply with the requests from the SFA in France.

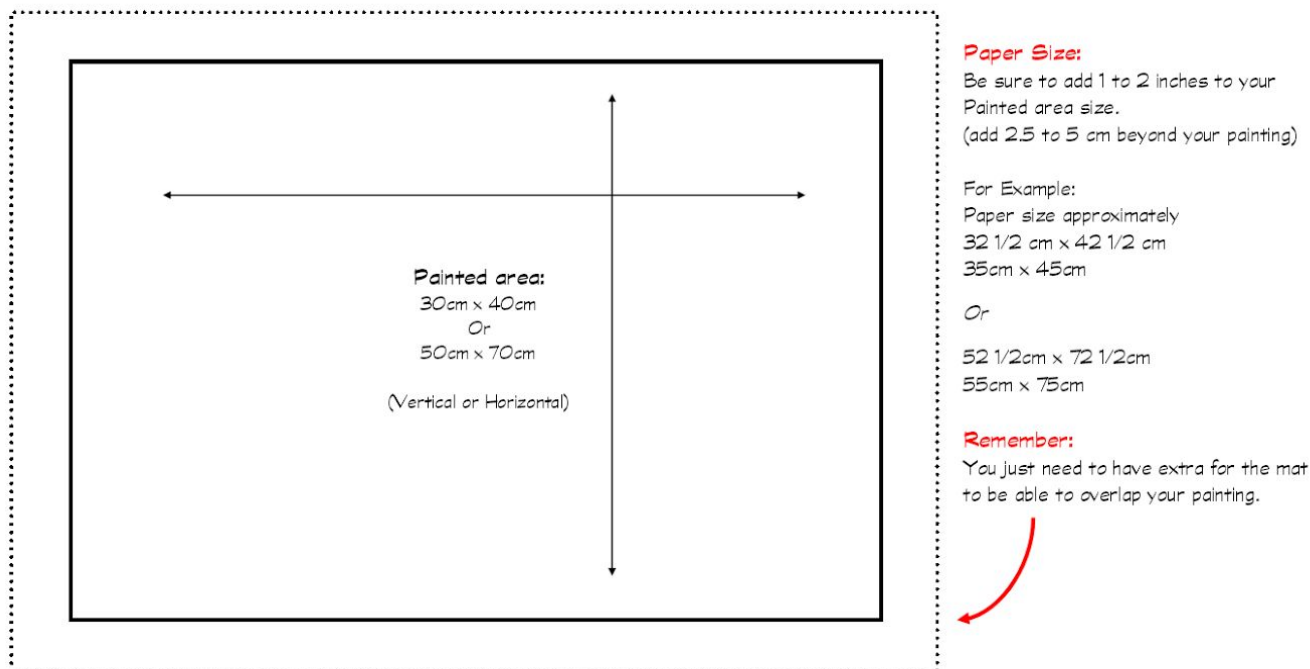
a) **Painted area:** 30cm x 40cm (11.8in x 15.74in) portrait or landscape

b) **Painted area:** 50cm x 70cm (19.6in x 27.5in) portrait or landscape

Please see diagram below on page 2 for further clarification on **Painted Area** and **Paper Size**

Note: New Information

The SFA has agreed that those paintings which are full sheets (22in x 30in) will be accepted - HOWEVER - the same window size will be the same on the mat. Therefore you have to expect that approximately 2 ¼ inches will be hidden by the mat.



Helson Gallery vs. Work selected for France

Helson Gallery (Canadian Portion of the Exhibition)

40 CSPWC paintings will be selected by the CSPWC Jurors

- 40 CSPWC (Canadian participation) Paintings will be selected for the Helson Gallery Exhibit. (selected by the CSPWC Jurors as above)
- 60 SFA (France participation) paintings will be sent over from France to the Helson Gallery. (selected by the SFA)

France Exhibition

60 CSPWC paintings will be sent to France selected by the CSPWC Jurors

- 40 CSPWC (Canadian participation) paintings from the Helson Gallery will be sent to France. (selected by the CSPWC Jurors as above)
- 20 CSPWC (Canadian participation) paintings will be added to this collection which will also be sent to France. (selected by the CSPWC Jurors as above)
- SFA (France participation) will include their members' paintings during this joint exhibition.

Framing

Framing instructions will be sent out to accepted members.

Be prepared:

Those accepted for the Helson Gallery joint exhibit

- To frame your painting with **metal frames** so that they can easily be dismantled.
- Your painting will be disassembled and will be sent to France unframed.
- You will be notified further procedures.

Those accepted for the France portion only

- Your acceptance letter will provide you with details regarding delivery of your painting.
- You will send your painting unframed according to the acceptance letter.

Where is the Gallery in France?

- The expo will take place from **September 1st to 16th**, at the **Cloitre St Louis** in **Avignon**.
- Official opening is on **Friday, August 31st at 6:30pm**.
- Canadian art works will be exhibited on the ground floor.
- On the 2nd and 3rd floors, the SFA will hold its annual member exhibitions.

Where can we stay if we choose to go to France?

You will be receiving an information brochure in regards to locations to stay in France upon acceptance of your paintings. All CSPWC members and Associates of the CSPWC are welcome to attend this exhibition.
